Romans 8:7-8

28 [a]For we maintain that a man is justified by faith apart from works [b]of the Law.

2 If Abraham was indeed justified by works, he had something to boast about, but not before God. 3For what does the Scripture say? "Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness."

4<u>Now the wages of the worker are not credited as a gift, but as an obligation</u>. 5However, to the one who does not work, but <u>believes in Him who justifies the wicked</u>, <u>his faith is credited as righteousness</u>

5I am the vine and you are the branches. The one who remains in Me, and I in him, will bear much fruit. For apart from Me you can do nothing

Romans 3:10-12, Psalm 14:1-3, Psalm 53:1-3 (The fool says in his heart there is no God)
